18 December and the report in accordance therewith be sent to him to be immediately answered]: he is hereby also required not to give any Obstruction Directly or Indirectly by himselfe or others to such Legall proceedings as the Petitioner shall have recourse to, for the Redresse of the Injury that he conceives to have been done him by the Actings of the two Pretended Justices of the Peace of the said Island mentioned in the said Report, or otherwise in relation to the Plantation in Question. And . . . in Case the Partys concerned or any of them aggrieved by any Sentence passed in this Matter in the Proper Courts of Justice in the Leeward Islands, they are not to be hindred from Appealing to his Majesty in Councill; Care being taken that as well the Defendants as Appellants do give Sufficient Security to abide by his Majestys Determination, and to Answer all Costs and Damages, that may have accrewed, and shall be awarded against them.
