

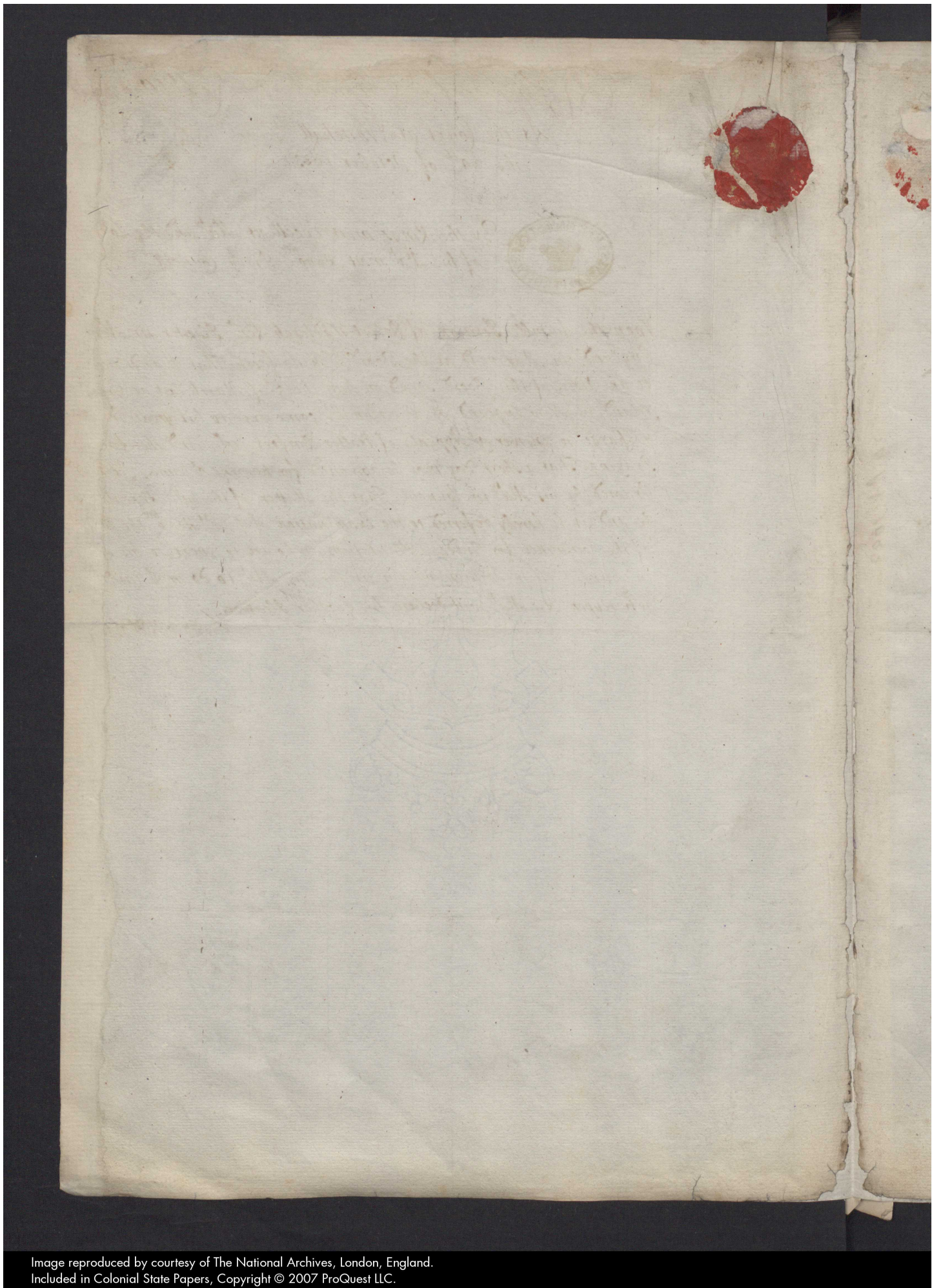
Reference of y^e Appeal of Rob^t Wadleigh
At the Court at Whitehall
the 24th of October 1683.



By the Kings most Excellent Ma^{ty} and the Lords
of his Ma^{ty} most Hono^{ble} Privy Council

Upon the humble Petition of Robert Wadleigh, Sen^r Planter in New
England this day read at the Board, setting forth That in obedience
to an Order of this Board served on him the 5th of March last at Great

& Charge to answer y^e Appeals of Walter Barfoot Esq^r. And therefore
Praying That a short day may be appointed for hearing y^e same. It was
Ordered by his Ma^{ty} in Council, That the Matter of the said Appeals

of the Committee for Trade & Plantations who are to report to his Ma^{ty}
in Council their Opinion what is fit for his Ma^{ty} to do in y^e Case
whereupon His Ma^{ty} will declare his further Pleasure.
