At the Court at Whitehall.
This 19th day of November, 1684.

By the Kings Most Excellent Ma^{ty} and the Lords
of his Ma^{ty}'s Most Hon^{ble} Privy Council.

Whereas by order of this Board of the 7th instant, the
Appeals of Sarah Bland, Widdow, from severall
Sentences pronounced ag^t her in the Generall Court
of his Ma^{ty}'s Colony of Virginia, in favour of Colonel
S^r Leger Codd, and Anna his Wife, was appointed to
be heard before his Ma^{ty} in Council this day. And
Whereas both parties did accordingly attend wth their
Councell Learned in the Law. His Ma^{ty} (upon hearing
Arguments on both sides) thought fitt to referre the
Examination of this matter to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lords
Committees of this Board for Trade, and forreigne
plantations, to report the state thereof, with their
Opinion thereupon & then his Ma^{ty} will declare his
further pleasure.


